

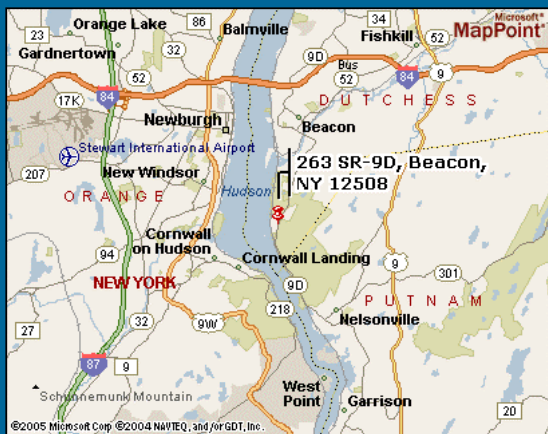
The Dutchess Manor is located at:

Take the Palisades Parkway North to the Bear Mountain Bridge. Cross the bridge and turn left onto 9D North and proceed North for 12.5 miles. Dutchess Manor is on your left.
